

BALDIVIS CABERNET SHIRAZ 2002

Baldivis Estate Wines are proudly made in Western Australia from premium fruit grown in selected regions. They represent excellent value Western Australian wines.

Winemaker: Tony Carapetis

Winemaker's Comments: This wine is a classic Australian combination of Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz.

Cabernet Sauvignon's rich fruit characters and firm tannins complement the lifted spicy attributes of Shiraz. This is a supple and full flavoured wine.

Suggested Food: char-grilled venison skewers, tomato based pasta or pizza.

Cellaring: 1-2 years

Viticulture: Fruit parcels for this wine were predominantly drawn from vineyards in the Geographe (66.3%) and Margaret River (21.3%) regions. Other premium WA regions made up the final blend.

Vinification: The Baldivis Estate Cabernet Shiraz was fermented on skins for 8 days before being pressed.

The wine was then matured in a combination of American and French Oak for 12 months prior to blending, filtration and bottling.
