

## BALDIVIS CHARDONNAY 2004

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Baldivis Estate Wines are proudly made in Western Australia from premium fruit grown in selected regions. They represent excellent value Western Australian wines.

**Winemaker:** Sarah Siddons

**Winemaker's Comments:** The 2004 Baldivis Estate Chardonnay is fruit-filled with lovely fresh peach and melon flavours and just a hint of creaminess from the malolactic fermentation.

**Suggested Food:** Seafood, chicken or salad dishes.

**Cellaring:** 1-2 years

**Viticulture:** The cool Western Australia summer in 2004 meant fruit took time to reach full ripeness and developed refined and complex flavour structures. Chardonnay was then sourced from premium regions including the Great Southern, Pemberton and Greater Perth areas.

**Vinification:** Crisp pear, apple and melon flavours combine with a hint of French oak, to produce a Chardonnay of delightful freshness and intensity. The fullness and creaminess on the palate adds to the wine's complexity and enjoyment.
